Warranty

Your Aviator F-Series smartwatch is made and tested to exacting standards. We warrant to the original consumer that the smartwatch will be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of two (2) years from date of purchase. During this period, the smartwatch will be repaired or replaced (at the sole discretion of Aviator F-Series smartwatches) free of charge, if it proves to be defective in material or workmanship under normal use.

This guarantee does not affect your consumer rights.

Water Resistance

Your Aviator F-Series smartwatch is IP67 water resistant, suitable for everyday use and is splash/ rain resistant.

Service and Repairs under Guarantee

IMPORTANT-Not covered by Guarantee:

1. Batteries, straps and bracelets
2. Damage caused by accident, misuse or lack of care
3. Water penetration (see Water Resistance)

If your smartwatch requires attention under the terms of the guarantee, then please post your smartwatch together with the Retailers Sales receipt or Proof of Purchase, the completed Guarantee slip on the back cover of this booklet and with a brief explanation of the nature of the fault, by Registered Post or recorded delivery to your nearest service centre.

Setting Up Your Aviator F-Series Smartwatch AVSW9369/ 9370.

The first step is to download and install the **AVIATOR Smart F Series App** in your mobile from the QR code on your box, watch or manual & create an account to sync the information.

IMPORTANT! Before using the smartwatch, please peel off the protective transparent film on the back of the smartwatch.



Charging Instructions (A)

Charge your watch fully for the first time before use. Connect the USB charger and place the back of the watch on the charger.

After a few seconds, the display will light up and indicate the charging progress.

Clean the surface of the charger of any debris or foreign material to avoid interference in charging.



Easy Switch Strap (B)

The Aviator F-Series smartwatch AVSW9369/ 9370 comes with an additional silicone band. This smartwatch contains two parts (watch body & strap). You can replace the strap by pressing the ear switch at the back of the strap towards the right or left.



Pairing

- Turn on the watch. Press & hold the pusher for 5 seconds until the smartwatch vibrates & screen turns on.
- To bind the smartwatch to your App → turn on BT in your mobile, then open the AVIATOR Smart F Series App & click the 1st or 3rd tab at the bottom of the page.
- Click "Add a Device" and select your Aviator smartwatch from the scanning list, then follow the steps as prompted by your phone.
- To identify your device, you can also go to the smartwatch → Settings → About → Version
- Click "Pair" & "Allow" when prompted with the Pairing request (Pair with Aviator9369/ 9370).
- Pairing Complete.

To unbind the watch, open the App & click "Remove" in the 3rd tab. After this step, choose "forget this device" or "Unpair" from the phone's BT settings.

Smart Watch Features



Menu (Swipe right from the left of the dial display)

The menu has an extensive range of features including activity (step counter), sleep, heart rate, phone calls, exercise, exercise records, BP, SpO2, weather, messages, camera, music, breathing, voice assistant, timer, alarm, stopwatch, cycle tracking (to track ovulation & menstruation), flashlight, find phone, calculator, world time, games, settings [display, vibration mode, DND, low power mode, phone (phone call: on/off, media audio, phone reset), system (restart, power on/ off, reset), About (Version & App QR Code)].



Activity

(Swipe left from the right of the dial display)
The smartwatch & app automatically tracks Steps taken. Scroll down for the number of steps, kcal, minutes & day trend.

Note – Movement stats reset to zero at midnight.



Messages

(Swipe upwards from the bottom of the dial display)
Sync incoming notifications from Whatsapp, Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, etc. The last 8 messages can be stored on the smartwatch.

You can switch the notifications on/off in the App → 3rd tab → Notifications.



Sleep

The smartwatch & app monitors the duration and quality of your sleep when you wear your device to bed.

Note – Sleep stats reset to zero at 10:00 pm.



Heart Rate

Tap to start measuring your heart rate. The smartwatch can also record your heart rate all day. In the app, under the 3rd tab → Others → Continuous Heart Rate or Full Day Heart Rate → frequency. You can also select a ceiling to warn you if your BPM reaches over this limit in the 3rd tab → Others → Heart Rate warning.



Blood Pressure

Tap to start measuring your blood pressure. The smartwatch & app can show the data of the last 7 times.



SpO2

Tap to start measuring your Blood Oxygen level. The smartwatch & app can show the data of the last 7 times.



Control centre

(Swipe downwards from the top of the dial display)

The control centre includes do not disturb (DND), battery saver, flashlight, phone call: on/off, brightness & settings [display, vibration mode, DND, low power mode, phone (call: on/ off, media audio, phone reset), system (restart, power on/off, reset), About (version & App QR code)]. It also has a battery life icon & a sync indicator which turns red when your app is disconnected.



Camera

After connecting the device, you can control your phone camera remotely through the smartwatch.



Music

After connecting the device, you can control your phone music player remotely through the smartwatch.



Exercise & Exercise Records

Choose your sport from over 100 different sports to start recording.

The last training recorded will be shown on the smartwatch & App main page (1st tab), whereas the exercise/ training records are shown in the App → 2nd tab.



Weather

Current weather and forecast of 7 days are shown on the Weather page.

Choose your city & temperature format in the App (3rd tab) → Others → Weather, to sync with your smartwatch.



Phone Calls

Calls can be made & answered on the smartwatch.

Note - If your smartwatch does not connect the calls & asks to try again, pair it under your phone's BT. If it still does not recognise it, click "phone reset" under settings, then pair it again. Ensure that your smartwatch is placed next to your phone.



World Time

Your watch can display the time of 6 different cities simultaneously. Add these cities of your choice in the App (3rd tab) → World Time.



Stopwatch

Tap the screen control to start, pause or reset the stopwatch.



Reminders to move & to drink water

The smartwatch will vibrate to remind you to move & to drink water at regular intervals.


Note: You can switch these features on/off in the app (3rd tab) → Others.



Alarm

Set up alarms on the smartwatch or app. The device will vibrate when the alarm goes off. You can set up to 8 alarms.

Personalize dials

Personalize your watch by adding a dial of your own choice from your personal gallery. In the App (3rd tab) → Watch Faces → Edit → swipe right on the dial faces until you reach the end → + (Choose from Album) → select photo → . You can see the download progress displayed on your watch screen.



Customize dials

You can choose to customize the text & its position on your dial. In the App (3rd tab) → Watch Faces → Edit → choose the position, text (date, sleep stats, HR or steps) and the color of the text. Ensure that your watch is connected to the App and placed close to your phone during the entire transfer process. Do not close the App or turn off your watch or phone during the dial transfer.

Cloud Dials

You can also download additional dials from the cloud to give your Aviator Smartwatch a new look every day! Choose from over 350 dials to match your mood and style. In the App (3rd tab) → Watch Faces → swipe right on the dial faces until you reach the end → + (Face gallery) → select photo → Download. The new dial will be soon transferred to your watch and you can see the download progress displayed on your watch screen. Ensure that your watch is connected to the App and placed close to your phone during the entire transfer process. Do not close the App or turn off your watch or phone during the dial transfer.

Know your device

1. Using in Wet Conditions

The device features IP67 water resistance, but this protection is not permanent and may reduce over time. The device can withstand perspiration, drops of water when washing the face, mild rainfall and other small amounts of moisture in daily activities.

Do not wear it when you are swimming, showering, diving, scuba diving, surfing or when engaged in high-velocity sports. Do not use the watch button when the device is wet. Ensure product is fully dry before using the button.

The following may affect the water resistance of the device:

- It is dropped, bumped, or encounters other impacts.
- It comes into contact with liquids including soap, shower gel, detergent, perfume, lotion, and oil.
- It is used in high-temperature and high-humidity environments including hot baths and saunas.
- Hot steam, smoke and other vapours can cause damage to the watch's sensitive sensors.

2. Using Quick View

With Quick View you can check the time or messages from your phone on your smartwatch without tapping. Just turn your wrist towards you and the screen will appear for a few seconds. You can switch this function on/off in the App (3rd tab) → Others → Quick View

Operating temperature: 14°F to 122°F (-10°C to 50°C)

Non-operating temperature: -4°F to 140°F (-20°C to 60°C)
